
WHEREAS, the town board has motioned at the March 14, 2005 meeting to dissolve the Interim Ordinance created on May 17, 2004;

The above-entitled matter came on before the Dead Lake Town Board on June 14, 2004. In accordance with Minnesota Statute § 462.355, Subd. 4, the Dead Lake Town Board shall only enforce those provisions of the interim ordinance passed that are more restrictive than Ottertail County's Ordinance.

Dead Lake Township shall not enforce any ordinance adopted by Ottertail County.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

I. The Dead Lake Town Board shall enforce the provisions of its interim ordinance, but shall not enforce any provision of the Ottertail County Ordinances, including the shoreland area as it is the county's duty to enforce county ordinances.
