# <u>Dead Lake Township Monthly Meeting Minutes</u> May 8, 2023

At 6:00 p.m., the meeting of Dead Lake Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Supervisor Chairperson Kirchenwitz.

**<u>Present:</u>** Justin Kirchenwitz, Dave Ellingson, Duane Ard, Dawn Lueders and Cheryl Harris

There were five people in the audience. (Sheet attached)

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those present.

<u>Monthly Meeting Minutes:</u> Supervisors reviewed the April minutes. A motion was made by Ard and seconded by Ellingson to approve the April 2023 Meeting Minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

**Financial Report:** Harris reported the figures for April 2023 as follows:

Verizon Lease Payment	\$ 4,249.33
Total	\$ 65,522.93

Harris reported that if needed we could borrow funds from the equipment fund as long as the money is replaced to the equipment fund as soon as possible. Kirchenwitz asked about when we make a lump sum payment to the loan from the Verizon fund. Harris stated that when the balance gets to about \$6,500 then we make a lump sum payment of \$5,000. A motion was made by Kirchenwitz to approve the April 2023 Financial Report. A second was made by Ard. Motion passed unanimously. Harris reported that the numbers for April for CTAS agreed with the Bank Statements. Harris reported that a total of \$1,840.91 was received during April 2023.

<u>Bills for May:</u> Lueders presented the bills for May 2023 to the Supervisors. After reviewing the bills, a motion was made by Kirchenwitz and seconded by Ard to approve the bills as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

Southview Lane: Kirchenwitz stated that both Edna and Rush Lake Townships spoke with Kirchenwitz after looking over the new Town Line Road Agreements. In the proposed Town Line Road Agreements, Dead Lake Township would take over the plowing and grading of Southview Lane; Rush Lake Township would take over the plowing and grading of 400<sup>th</sup> Avenue and South Marion Drive; and Edna Township would be a one-third partner in payments of all expenditures of Southview Lane. Edna and Rush Lake Township said the 20<sup>th</sup> of May at 10:00am would work for them to have the hearing at the Dead Lake Town Hall and sign the new Town Line Agreements if that schedule works with the Dead Lake Supervisors. Kirchenwitz made a motion to set the special meeting with Edna, Rush Lake and Dead Like Townships for Saturday, May 20<sup>th</sup> at 10:00am for the purpose of accepting Southview Lane as a township road and sign the new Town Line Road Agreements with Edna and Rush Lake Townships. Ellingson seconded and the motion was carried unanimously. Harris will send out copies of the new Town Line Road Agreements for the board. Lueders will get the notice in the paper and posted.

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<u>Verizon</u>: Harris received another letter from Verizon wanting to settle on a lease payment amount. The letter Harris received basically said that if Dead Lake Township does not agree to what Verizon wants to pay, Verizon may take the tower down. Harris told them to contact Kennedy Graven with any questions or correspondence. Kirchenwitz told Harris that fi she receives any further correspondence from Verizon to pass it along to Kirchenwitz and he will take care of it.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

<u>Trees on 360<sup>th</sup> Street:</u> And stated that Wells Excavating is contacting the landowners regarding the removal of the trees. Jeff Wells told And he should have the trees done in about two to three weeks.

Cozy Cove Liquor License: Lynn Gribble from Cozy Cove Resort was at the meeting to request Township approval for their On-Sale and Off-Sale of 3.2 Malt Liquor, and On-Sale Wine license. This license will take effect on July 1<sup>st</sup> and will be renewed annually going forward. A previous request was made for a temporary license due to the name change of the business. The request was looked over and Kirchenwitz motioned to approve Cozy Cove's Liquor License. Ard seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

**Road Tour:** Supervisors discussed the road tour (see attached sheet)

County Bridge Report: Lueders reported that the County Bridge Report received did not have any suggestions for any repairs.

<u>Chloride petitions and payments:</u> All the payments have been received from the residents on the 2023 Chloride list except one. Duane brought one new request that was received. Lueders added the new request to the list. Any new requests received will be considered if they are received before the chloride is applied. The Supervisors discussed when to put up the stakes to mark the roads for chloride treatment. It was decided that the Supervisors would go mark the roads right after the hearing on May 20<sup>th</sup>. Lueders will get the notice posted.

<u>Shared town line road agreements</u>: The agreement with Edna Township just needed some updating in the language. The agreement doesn't currently have whether it is a Street or Avenue. Harris will update the agreement and email it out to the Board. Rush Lake's agreement will include all the plowing and grading for 400<sup>th</sup> Avenue and South Marion Drive, since Dead Lake Township will be taking over all the plowing and grading for Southview Lane if it is accepted at the hearing on May 20<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Beaver leveler on Beaver Dam Road:</u> Kirchenwitz called Larime Barry about putting the leveler back in for the Township. Barry got back to Kirchenwitz and said within the next couple of weeks he would get the leveler and put it back in.

<u>Deputy Treasurer:</u> Lueders introduced Tammy Trosdahl to the Supervisors. Trosdahl was recommended for the position. Lueders felt that Trosdahl would be a good fit for the Board as she has a good work ethic and wants things done correctly with good attention to detail. Kirchenwitz made the motion to hire Trosdahl as the Deputy Treasurer at \$25 per hour plus mileage. After a training period of about two months Trosdahl will take over as the Treasurer. Ard seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

<u>Bank letter for signatures:</u> Lueders presented a letter to the Supervisors to sign that would add Tammy Trosdahl as Deputy Treasurer to the bank accounts.

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<u>Matual Approach</u>: Ellingson reported that he went and looked at the approach for Mark Matual, and it is complete. We can issue a letter approving the approach and return the deposit check.

#### **Housekeeping Items:**

There were three housekeeping items.

The next regular Board Meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. on June 12, 2023, at the Dead Lake Township Hall.

Having no further Township business to conduct, Kirchenwitz motioned to adjourn the meeting. Ard seconded. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:03 p.m.

### 2023 Dead Lake Township Road Tour May Notes

<u>375<sup>th</sup> Ave</u>: Add culvert by Baartson's to move water off the road. Kirchenwitz met with Ryan Fithen, from Mr. D's Excavating about getting a culvert in on the south side of the driveway. A culvert will help with most of the water but not all of it. The cost would be \$975.00 to install the culvert. Motion made by Ard and seconded by Ellingson to get the culvert put in. Motion carried unanimously.

Govern Rd: Asphalt patch. See notes for 360th Street below.

360<sup>th</sup> St: Asphalt patches. Kirchenwitz got a quote from Performance Paving to repair the areas needing patches. Dan Hendershot from Performance Paving gave a quote for four areas on 360<sup>th</sup> but there wasn't one for Govern Road. Kirchenwitz will reach out to Hendershot for clarification on his quote and revisit both 360<sup>th</sup> St. and Govern Road needs next month for patching. There was also discussion on options available since there is constant patching being done and the cost involved.

375<sup>th</sup> St, 390<sup>th</sup> Ave, 385<sup>th</sup> St: Gravel from 14 to just west of the of 385<sup>th</sup> Ave. It was motioned by Kirchenwitz and seconded by Ard to apply gravel to these roads. Motion carried unanimously.

385<sup>th</sup> Ave: 2 trees on the lakeside to be removed, owners need to be contacted. Gravel 385<sup>th</sup>. Being the trees are so close to the road, they are a hazard for the snowplow and grader. It was noted that when snow plowing, the road gets very narrow through this section and this past winter was only wide enough for one vehicle. There was a motion made by Ard and seconded by Ellingson to send a letter to the landowners letting them know the Township's intent to remove the trees. The landowners can request a hearing within 14 days of the letter date. The motion carried unanimously. It was decided to wait until next year, before the chloride is applied, to apply gravel to 385<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

397<sup>th</sup> St: Sign to be put back up, found sandbags and rebar blocking a culvert on road. We removed them and will keep an eye on it to see if the owner puts it back. Kirchenwitz noted that the sign has been put back up. Kirchenwitz also stated that the rebar and sandbags were back in the culvert. Kirchenwitz removed the rebar and sandbags again. Lueders was asked to send a letter to the landowners asking them to remove the items if the items belong to them.

<u>Southview LN:</u> Supervisors went down this road to check the road out as requested by residents. The resident's request is to have the 3 bordering townships take the road into a township road. Other than a couple of branches the road is in pretty good shape. Edna Township, who was also on their road tour, stopped and Jeff Guck from Rush Lake Township was there as well. While many other things would need to be completed it appears the 3 townships would work together to get this road taken care of. Refer to regular meeting minutes. The hearing is set for May 20<sup>th</sup> at 10:00am to meet with Edna and Rush Lake Township to decide if Southview Lane will be accepted as a Township Road.

<u>Beaver Dam Road</u>: There is a low spot North of Eric Hanson's that needs gravel. <u>Motion by Kirchenwitz and seconded by Ard to add gravel to this area of Beaver Dam Road</u>. <u>Motion carried unanimously</u>.

**Notes:** There were several trees and limbs down from the winter especially from the last heavy snow we got; tree trimmer will take care of these. Supervisors cleaned up 2 areas with excessive damage in yards from winter plowing. Al Sazama has some of the debris cleaned up and will finish the rest of the areas.
